¹Note by Will Graves: I have included this roster on our database because the invalid regiment commanded by Col. Lewis Nicola included convalescent men from all lines of the Continental Army serving under George Washington in Pennsylvania including Mike Mankin's ancestor Benjamin Sadler who was a member of the 9th Virginia Regiment. Mike's discovery of this roster is a very significant addition to this database even though it will include men who did not service in the Southern Campaigns.
